OUTDOOR PURSUITS & OUTDOOR SKILLS

For Grade 9-11 Graduates



Outdoor Pursuits (OP) & Outdoor Skills (OS) are companion programs designed to be taken after our Outreach program. These 18 and 16- day programs respectfully, focus on refining a wide range of wilderness skills and expanding student's leadership abilities. As each program explores new terrain and requires a new skill set, OP and OS can be taken in any order before continuing on to our instructor level programs, WIC and KIC.

Beyond the challenges created by new locations and new skills, students will take on a larger role in trip planning and leadership, campcraft (cooking, camp setup, critter-proofing) and environmental stewardship.

Outdoor Pursuits combines an 8-day canoe trip in Killarney Provincial Park or the Temagami Wilderness Area with a 7-day hiking trip to the Adirondack High Peaks Region in New York State. OP is where skills learned in quest and outreach are put to the test and built upon.

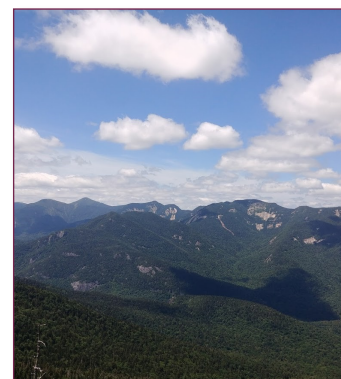
