

OUTDOOR SKILLS

For Grade 9-11 Graduates



Outdoor Skills (OS) is designed to be taken after our Outreach program. This 16-day program focuses on refining a wide range of wilderness skills and expanding student's leadership abilities. The OS program explores new terrain and will teach students a whole new set of skills.

Beyond the challenges created by new locations and new skills, students will take on a larger role in trip planning and leadership, camp craft (cooking, camp setup, critter-proofing) and environmental stewardship.

Outdoor Skills combines a 9-day kayak trip on Georgian Bay with a 4-day moving water canoe course at Palmer Rapids on the Madawaska River. The wide open horizon of Georgian Bay provides a unique backdrop for Ontario, while, Palmer Rapids is considered a top spot for safely learning moving water canoeing.
