
ADER IN TRAINING

A Wilderness Leadership Experience in French River and Georgian Bay For Grade 10 and 11 Graduates



LIT is where it all comes together! The objective of this course is to equip students with the experience, certifications, and knowledge to someday work in the outdoor industry. This course begins with a 13 day long expedition that provides students with an opportunity to learn the fundamentals of coastal kayaking

and white water canoeing, as well as invaluable leadership and interpersonal skills. Students will spend 6 days on a moving water canoe trip down the French River, followed by a transition day of gear and boats, and another 6 days kayaking on Georgian Bay.
